How is Our School Development Plan Used?

- Guides ongoing assessment and review of goals and actions.
- Our school development plan is the driver for closing learning gaps and informs:
 - Instructional strategies
 - Professional learning
 - School structures and processes for learning
 - Resources to improve student learning
 - Data-informed decision making



School Development Plan – Overall Goal



Assessment of learning is a practice that is woven throughout daily learning experiences and supports teachers in designing appropriate tasks and making responsive teaching adjustments.



Teachers will demonstrate a greater understanding of and confidence in reporting on students' abilities and understanding and will apply feedback to move learning forward.



Our work in assessment will improve how we plan cycles of learning and use student data to adjust our teaching.





School Development Plan – Overall Goal

Our focus this year will be to improve assessment practices by:

- Using varied assessment modes (product, conversation, observation)
- Creating a rich feedback culture (self-reflection, peer and teacher assessment)
- Assessing with proficiency (learning progressions)

School Development Plan - Literacy Improvement



Teachers are working to implement research-informed, explicit and systematic literacy teaching practices. Increasing teacher knowledge and skill in monitoring progress will improve student learning.



- Our school received **1 942 117** in 2023-24 to provide a quality education to our students and meet the goals in our school development plan (SDP).
- At least 75 per cent of budgeted funds covers staffing and the remaining portion covers instructional and operational supplies.
